To Whom It May Concern:

The Berlin Public School System is responsible for the identification of children and youth with disabilities between birth and 21 years of age. The school system will provide screening and, where indicated, a comprehensive evaluation to determine if a student has a disability that impacts learning and is in need of special education services. Services are provided by the school system for students with disabilities, ages 3-21, and within the region by various public and private service providers for children ages birth to three.

If you or someone on your staff knows of a child who may have a disability and has not been identified by the school system, please ask the child's parents to contact the Berlin Public Schools, Department of Pupil Personnel Services at 860-828-6581.
