Spirit Wear orders can be picked up between 7:30 and 8:10 AM each day this week in the school lobby.

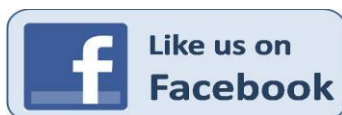
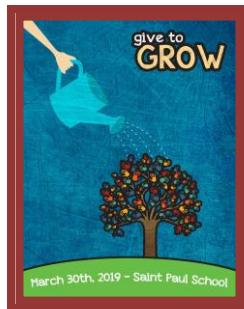
