These results are very important to us in planning our programs and instruction for next year to assure that we continue to meet the needs of every student.

- In addition, each referring family's name will be placed into a drawing for a **\$500.00** tuition credit for the following school year (2018-19), for **each family they referred who enrolls at Saint Paul School.**
- If the referring family has only one student attending Saint Paul School as an 8th grader during the 2017-18 school year, then the \$500.00 tuition credit will be applied to the current school year.
