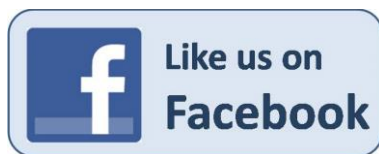
Our Spring Band Concert will be held on Monday, May 21st at 1:30 PM. Please join us! All are welcome to attend!
