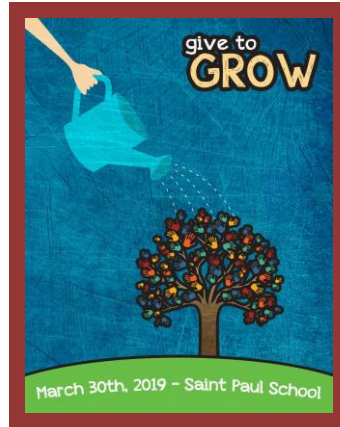
Our St. Paul Middle School Bible Study will be meeting again in late January! New members are welcome to join us!
