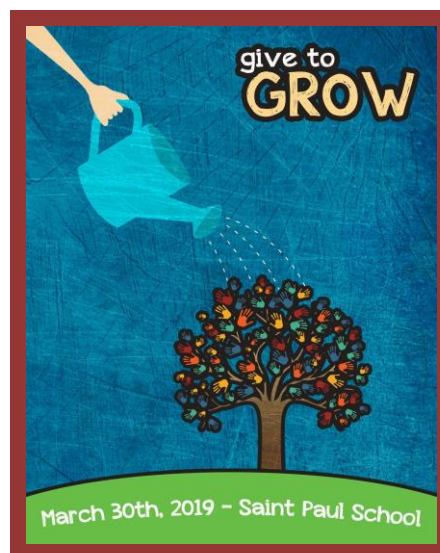
Please see the attached flyer for CT STORM, a central CT youth track and field club for grades 4-8. Many of our students have participated in the past.
